The Cardiff Bay Barrage approach channel sector light has been removed for repair.

Mariners are directed to navigate this area with increased caution during hours of darkness and to navigate using the remaining approach channel buoyage and aids to navigation.

Vessels wishing to enter or leave Cardiff Bay should contact Barrage Control on VHF Channel 18 and await instructions before entering the Outer Harbour.

Vessels should also navigate with caution in the approach channel for the duration of the dredging works and whilst the buoyage is off station.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
