#### No. 18 – Home Countries Rowing International – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday 23rd July 2016

The Home Countries Rowing international will be held in Cardiff Bay on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday 23rd July. Prior to the event, works will be carried out in the Bay to establish the rowing course and after the event for its removal.

### Rowing lane set up:

From Wednesday 6th July, the 1,500 metre rowing lane course will be set out in Cardiff Bay.

The course will be marked by an exclusion zone of yellow buoys running down the length of the course between the Barrage sluices and the Inner Harbour (see attached plan). Vessels must keep clear of the exclusion zone, which will contain underwater obstructions, and navigate at slow speed when vessels are working on the course.

Access to and from the Inner Harbour will be via a buoyed channel on its western side, which will be laid as part of the works.

#### Rowing activity:

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July and Saturday 23rd July, practice and competition racing will take place.

A 5 knot maximum speed limit will be in place within all areas of Cardiff Bay during the following times:

Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> 1000 hrs – 1400 hrs (then practice continues until 1630 with no 5 knot

limit)

Saturday 23rd 0930 hrs - 1700 hrs

Mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone and to navigate at slow speed in its vicinity to keep wash to a minimum. The buoys marking the outside of the exclusion zone will be lit

Access to the Pay and Display pontoons in the Inner Harbour will also be restricted although alternative mooring will be available in the Graving Dock.

Removal of the rowing lane course will commence from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July. It is anticipated the course will be removed by approximately Friday 29th July. The exclusion zone of yellow buoys running down the length of the course between the Barrage sluices and the Inner Harbour will remain in place until this is complete and access to and from the Inner Harbour will remain via the buoyed channel on its western side. Vessels must keep clear of the exclusion zone, which will contain underwater obstructions, and navigate at slow speed when vessels are working on the course.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
