**Cardiff Triathlon – Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017  
Dredging works in the River Taff and deposition in Cardiff Bay**

**No 8 of 2017 – Cardiff Triathlon – Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> 2017**

On Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June, the Cardiff Triathlon will be taking place in Cardiff Bay.

Vessels are requested to keep clear of the race area (see attached plan A) between the following times:

Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June 0700 hrs – 1230 hrs

The race area will be marshalled by Harbour Authority and Race Control vessels. The Harbour Authority Pay and Display pontoons at Roald Dahl Plass will be closed to all vessels during this time.

Alternative mooring is available in Graving Dock No.3 during this time.

**Mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone and to navigate at dead slow speed in its vicinity to keep wash to a minimum.**

**No 09 of 2017 – Dredging works in the River Taff and deposition in Cardiff Bay**

Dredging works in the vicinity of Taff's Mead and Castle water bus stops on the River Taff are due to commence on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2017 and last for approximately 4 weeks.

During the dredging works the support vessel 'Spot On' will be in operation towing barges between the dredge site and the deposition area in the Bay. 'Spot On' will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 18.

The deposition area shown on the attached plan will be marked by four special marks (Yellow buoy, Fl. Y – Plan B). The deposition barge will remain at anchor within this area for the duration of the dredge campaign and will display an anchor ball / all round white light.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear of vessels associated with the dredging and the deposition area. The barges and towing vessel may be stationary for extended periods whilst depositing spoil.

Mariners should note that navigation upstream of Penarth Road Bridge will be restricted whilst the dredging is in progress. Vessels requiring access beyond this point should contact the Harbour Master's office on tel 029 2087 7900.

**Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.**
