**No. 07 - CIWW STAND UP PADDLE BOARD RACE - RIVER ELY
AND TAFF**

No 07 - CIWW Stand Up Paddle Board Race - River Ely and Taff– 5th of May 2019

The CIWW Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP) racing will take place on the River Ely and River Taff from Cardiff International White Water (CIWW) on Sunday 5th May 2019.

The first race will start from CIWW at 1000 hrs and take place on the River Ely with the last competitor expected to have completed the course by 1200hrs. There will be five accompanying event support vessels on the water at all times.

The second race will start at 1300 hrs and competitors will head from CIWW, down stream to the Bay, turn left across the Bay and into the Taff until the stadium. The turning point will be marked by a yellow pillar buoy on the River Taff outside the Principality Stadium. The course will then be reversed. The last competitor is expected to have completed the course by 1500hrs.

There will be five accompanying event support vessels on the water at all times and vessels navigating the Rivers are asked to keep wash to a minimum during racing.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
