

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 13 of 2020 – Return to Routine Locking Operations Timetable

Mariners are advised that from 00:01 on Monday 24th August 2020, locking through Cardiff Bay Barrage will return to the normal timetable both on weekends and during the week.

Outbound - On the hour and half past the hour

Inbound - Quarter past and quarter to the hour

Mariners should consider the amended regulations when deciding to travel to and use their vessels to avoid placing any **unnecessary strain and risk on the emergency services**.

When using the Barrage locks please remain on board your vessel however if you are required to step onto the pontoons to moor up then please be patient for other users and maintain social distancing.

Up to date information may be obtained from Barrage Control on 029 2070 0234 or on VHF Channel 18.

Many vessels within the Harbour will not have been used for a considerable time. In order to minimise the need for the emergency services to be mobilised, potentially placing them and you at risk, the following conditions should apply:

- The latest weather forecast should be obtained and vessels are to be checked and inspected thoroughly before leaving the berth. This should include ensuring that all boat systems and engines are operating correctly and all equipment is in date and operating as it should.
- Lifejackets or buoyancy aids should be worn by all on-board for your own safety.
- Mariners are urged to exercise good seamanship, courtesy, patience and common sense as they begin to move around the Harbour.
- The skipper and crew of all vessels are required to follow government guidance in relation to Covid-19 to protect themselves and others they may come into contact with.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
