

# **LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS**

## **No 16 of 2021 – CBYC hosting 2000 Class Inland Championships 16-17 October 2021**

Cardiff Bay Yacht Club are hosting the 2000 class Inland Championships in Cardiff Bay on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2021. This national event is expected to attract approximately 100 competing boats.

Racing is expected to commence at 1125 hrs on Saturday, and 1025 on Sunday. Racing may continue through to late afternoon. Courses will be set to ensure that access around the Bay (in particular between the locks and the Inner Harbour) is maintained, although exact layouts will depend on weather conditions at the time. Club safety vessels will be on the water whilst the event is in progress.

Mariners are requested to give the racing fleet as wide a berth as possible during the racing and, in any case, to navigate around small craft at slow speed.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
